

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PATCHING

Patch fabric textile sheet Thermo coated TPU2 (low temperature) | Item 106856



Cut the fabric for patching a bit larger than the tear.



Take off the protective sheet and glue the patch from the inside onto the tear.
ATTENTION: The adhesive side of the patch can stick with an iron. For large holes use two patches (glue to the hole from the outside and inside), for small holes place baking paper on top from the outside.

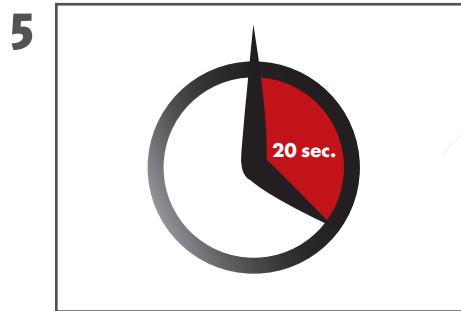


Insert a smooth and thin piece of wood. Otherwise you'll lose the pressure of the iron to the chainsaw protection.



Now the patch can be sealed onto the fabric. Use an iron without steam and preheat to the highest temperature. (ca 180°C – 200°C)

IMPORTANT: Use non-stick coated paper (baking paper) or other patch to avoid sticking to the iron.



Now press the heated iron for about 20 sec. on the patch, until the patch has merged with the fabric.



Cut off any threads sticking out.

The patch fabric textile sheet is used to repair various types of clothing.

ATTENTION: May not be applied to coated garments!

Available in the colours: fluorescent orange (25), red (40), bottle green (59) and grey (90).
